Curved piecing directions for the Solomon's Puzzle quilt square template set.

- 1. There are 2 pieces in this set. First, is the outer edge. Second, is the inner circle shaped piece.
- 2. These templates are backed with a product that will eliminate slippage. Follow around the template with your rolling cutter. If you use the Martelli Roundabout and cutting mat, simply turn the top as you cut!
- 3. After cutting both of the templates out, keep the pieces A & B.
- 4. Match notches in centers of both pieces (Diagram 2). Place a pin at the top, right on the edge of the fabric. Then, pin, taking a larger amount of fabric in the center. Align the edges at the top to start. Sew to notch and check the edge alignment for the edges to match to the bottom of the curve. Use a stiletto to guide the fabric.
- 5. OR! Use "Curve Master", and place the pieces right sides together and begin a ¼" seam starting at the top. Gently guide the pieces (right sides together) into the edge of the "Curve Master" and guide the fabric as the foot follows the curve fed into the needle to be sewn.
- 6. Turn right side out and press do not push iron. As this is a bias edge and will lose its shape if pushed or puller.
- 7. There are many patterns in which the pieces can be put together (diagram 3).
